Disciplinary Policy

Asalaamu Alaikum,

Tabarakallah Academy strives to create a safe, successful and educational environment for all. In order to achieve this, we rely heavily on the cooperation of staff, parents, children and community members to ensure that success. Below, please find a description of our disciplinary policy.

1. Each student will be given 2 warnings for unacceptable behavior. Unacceptable behavior is any action that is deemed disruptive or unsafe to the teacher, other students or themselves.
2. Upon receiving the 3rd warning, parents will be informed and must accompany the student to class until behavior improves.
3. If unacceptable behavior continues after parental presence the student will be suspended for three sessions (weekends) before being allowed back to class.
4. If unacceptable behavior persists the student will be suspended indefinitely and may not be allowed back into the program the following year.
